First Grade Supply List

- 1 black and white composition notebook with dotted midlines for upper/lowercase letters and drawing section
- 1 plastic pencil box (2 1/4"H x 5 5/8"W x 8 3/4"L)
- 1 pack of number 2 pencils (Ticonderoga 12 Pack)
- Two Pink Pearl erasers
- Two boxes of Crayola crayons (24 count)
- Four Large Elmer's Glue sticks
- 1 pair of Fiskars scissors
- 1 Low Oder black Dry Erase Marker
- 2 Black Sharpie Marker
- 1 pack of Crayola colored pencils (12 count)
- 6 - 2 pocket plastic folders with prongs (solid colors, one must be red)
- headphones for Technology (Placed in a labeled gallon size zip lock bag)
- Cloth Napkin to placed daily in your child's lunchbox

Have your child bring the above items with them on the first day of school. The red plastic folder will be our communication folder which does not need to be labeled. The other 5 plastic folders must be labeled. One Reading, Spanish, Science, Art, and Music.

Please make sure that your child's pencil box is filled with the following:

1. One Pink Pearl Eraser
2. One box of crayons (out of the box and placed in a small zip lock bag)
3. One large glue stick
4. One pair of scissors
5. One Low Oder black Dry Erase Marker
6. One Black Sharpie
7. One Pack of colored pencils (out of the box)

All extra supplies should be placed in a labeled gallon size plastic bag. I will store the items for the students in my supply closet. ☺
