SUPPLY LIST FOR GRADE 3

For individual use:

- 1 standard-size plastic **pencil box** (8"x4.5"x2") labeled with first and last name and filled with:
 - o 10 colored pencils
 - 24 Crayola crayons
 - o 2 glue sticks
 - 1 red ball-point pen
 - 1 yellow highlighter
 - o 1 eraser
 - o 5 pencil top erasers
 - o 1 pair of pointed student scissors
 - o 1 covered pencil sharpener
 - 2 black or blue EXPO markers and a small dry eraser
- 1 one-inch three ring binder (empty), (any color/design) with first and last name on top of spine

- Headphones (not earbuds) in a plastic Ziploc bag with first and last name
