- Balance \$7,101
- 2017/2018 school year we raised \$43,000
 - o Top fundraisers: Silent Auction raised \$21,000, Walk A Thon raised \$7,300
 - O Donation of \$40,000 back to the school for the playscape
 - o \$9,000 set aside for the completion of the playscape (rock wall and slides)
- NUT cards currently up to about \$1,000 in sales (\$15 for each NUT card, increase in cost from previous years of \$10 each card); NUT days purchased individually will remain at \$2 each
- Fundraising goal for 2018/219 school year is \$34,000
