- Supervise students in various settings and during non-instructional times such as lunch, recess, arrival/dismissal, and bus duty.
- Participate in school events, assemblies, extracurricular activities and contribute to a positive school culture.
- Perform additional responsibilities as requested by the school administration to support school operations and student safety.
